Remember more than one guy asking the same person at different times has proven very effective. Plan ahead for selected candidates.





There's no elimination period to satisfy for the Care Management Benefit, so a care manager can be assigned right away. The care manager then will assess your needs, develop an individualized plan of care and help arrange for long-term care services. (Ask your Field Agent for more details.)

Informal Caregiver Training Benefit – Our policy pays for expenses incurred for Informal Caregiver Training received by an informal (unpaid) caregiver for up to the policy limits.
