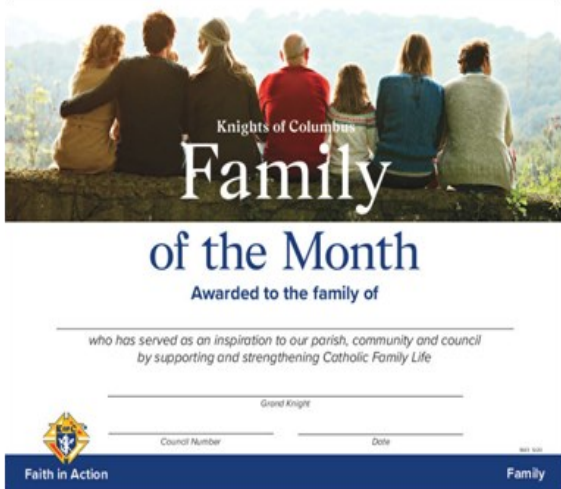
4th Degree Honor Guard Easter Events
